AND IN THY PEACE THY SERVANTS KEEP.



in remembrance of me.

having in remembrance his death once  
for all upon the cross,

and as we eat and drink these holy gifts  
in the presence of your divine majesty,  
fill us with your grace and heavenly  
blessing;  
nourish us by his body and blood,  
that we may grow into his likeness  
and, make one by your spirit,  
become a living temple to your glory.

Through Jesus Christ our Lord,  
by whom, and with whom, and in whom,  
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,  
all honour and glory be yours,  
almighty Father,  
from all who stand before you in earth  
and heaven,  
now and for ever. Amen.
